

June 1, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL AND SNOW UPDATE

Wolf Creek Summit in the Upper Rio Grande is now the only SNOTEL site that still has a significant snowpack, but it is now down to 20 inches from last week's 28 inches, and so it too will soon be gone. The chance of additional precipitation this week is very low. 2010 has turned out to be about average in terms of snowpack/precipitation. Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo increased about 22,000 ac-ft this past week as the flow at San Marcial has exceeded the release rate from Caballo. However, storage is still more than 60,000 ac-ft below its level on this date last year.

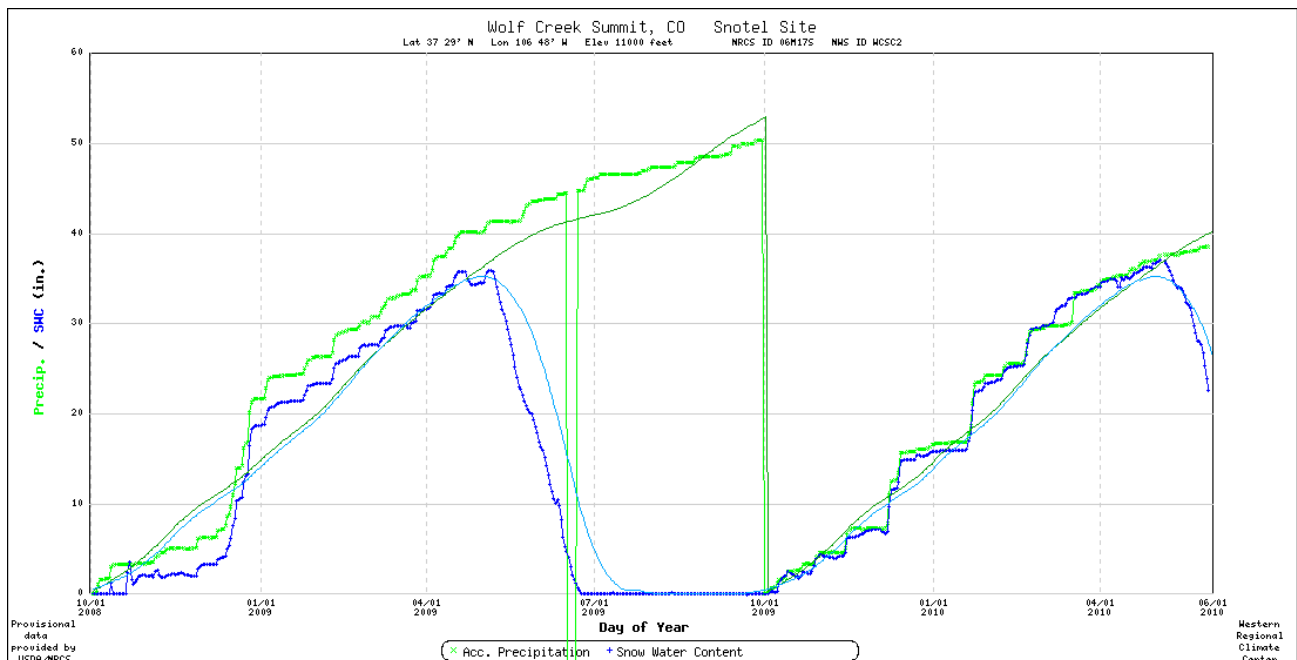
COMBINED STORAGE Elephant Butte and Caballo May 30, 2010 657,579 acre-feet
