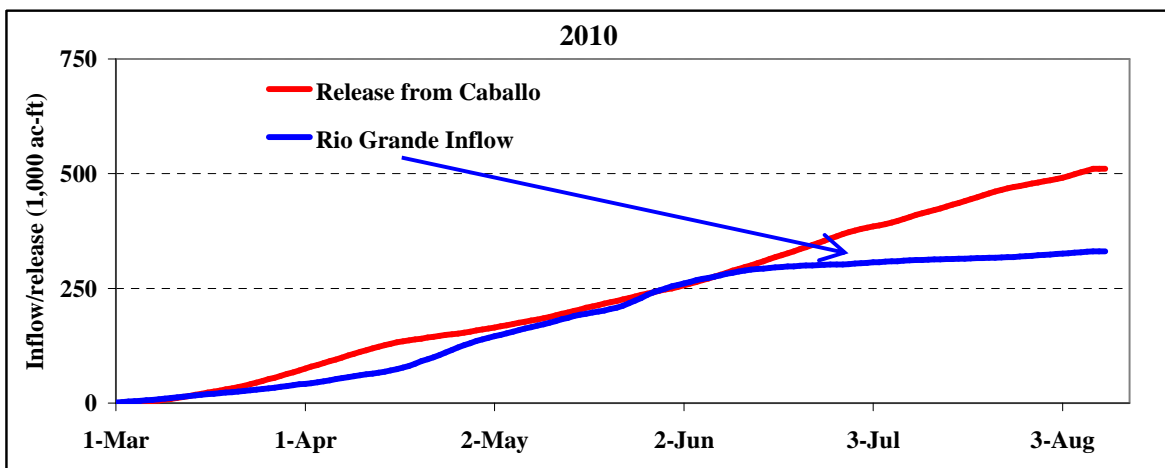
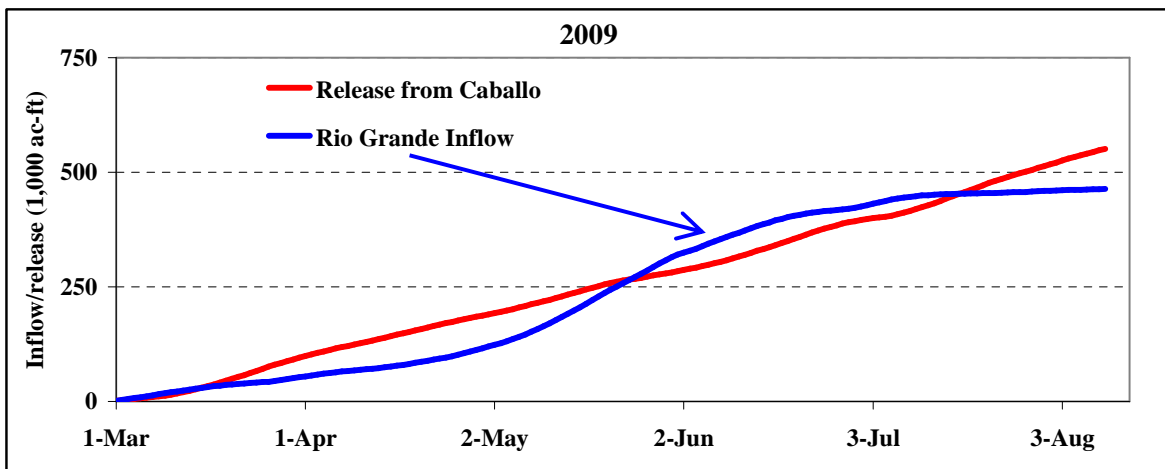
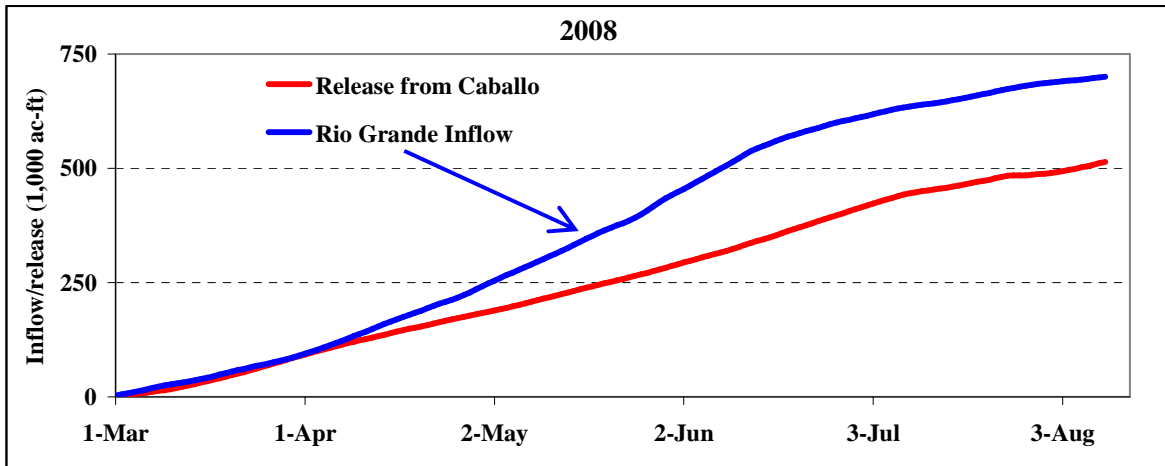
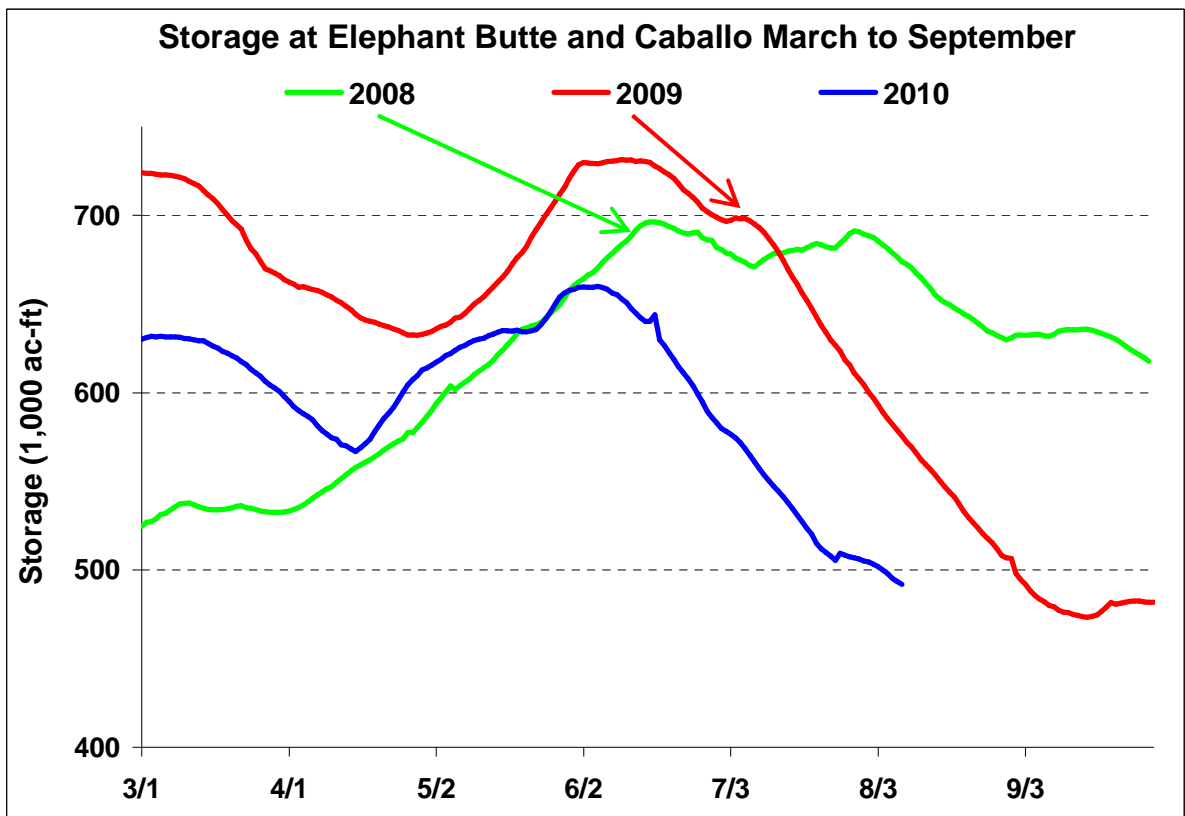


August 10, 2010 RESERVOIR LEVEL UPDATE

Storage in Elephant Butte/Caballo is decreasing, as is typical, and is now below 500,000 ac-ft. Projections are that storage will fall below 300,000 ac-ft by the end of September. So far this year, cumulative flow in the floodway and conveyance channel at San Marcial is a little higher than the average for the preceding 10 years, but lower than it has been the past 3 years and lower than the long term average. Release from Caballo has been about the same the past three years
