Candidate Eligibility Requirements: **In order to be a candidate, a person must:**

- 1. Be a U.S. Citizen;**
- 2. Be no less than 18 years of age as of May 4, 2024;**
- 3. Have resided continuously in Texas for 12 months (since February 16, 2023) ;**
- 4. Have resided continuously in the division from which the office is elected for six months (since August 16, 2023);**
- 5. Own agricultural land subject to District taxation in the division from which the candidate is running;**
- 6. Not have been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate jurisdiction to be totally mentally incapacitated or partially mentally incapacitated without the right to vote;**
- 7. Not have been finally convicted of a felony from which the person has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities; and**
- 8. Have timely filed with the District a completed application for candidacy.**
